



# Movement Friendly Regranting

*we're doing things differently*

*The Movements Trust* is advocating for better grant making processes that don't discriminate against social movements. Our objectives in acting as a regranting intermediary are to follow trust based principles

We will regrant for donors that will follow the following criteria and principles:

1. Open to funding informal and unregistered movements and preferably, be intent on developing own processes to open up to a greater variety of entities than just charities.
2. Offer funds upfront, not in retrospect
3. Commit to a fast turnaround in grant decision making and distribution - maximum a month between the finalisation of offer/paperwork and the funds arriving with the movement.
4. Be open to funding individuals or movements in earliest stages of inception
5. Genuinely open to trust based and relational funding
6. Be open to using existing due diligence and project information for the ease of the applicant, and be open to sharing documents in future with other donors for the same purposes

Mindful of our obligations set out under the *Charity Commission* guidance, we offer the maximum flexibility to movements whilst ensuring that their activities are charitable

Foundations using us will use our trust-based, relational approach to supporting movements during the grant period

- A co produced grant agreement
- A mid point check-in workshop for movements to meet each other as well as us
- Short survey after 6 or 12 months (depending on grant size), offering a range of formats
